





MORE TALES OF OLD HOLMESFIELD

During the second World War steel workers from Sheffield would catch a bus to Holmesfield at weekends and patronise the village public houses. Some of them would occasionally walk down to Millthorpe to enjoy gammon and eggs at the cafés. These weekend outings were considered necessary for the workmen who were doing vital work for the production of steel for munitions and aircraft engines. I was told that it wasn't unusual to see up to five or six double decked buses on Cartledge Lane waiting to take the workers back to Sheffield.

In these war years the playground at the roadside was divided by a barrier separating the boys and the girls. There was nothing else at the front of the school but at the rear of the school building was a field which was cultivated by some of the pupils to grow vegetables. One farmer's son staggered up to the school carrying a bucket filled with cow manure but even though he grew good crops he was disqualified because it was considered that he had obtained an unfavourable advantage.

If enemy aircraft flew over, everyone - both teachers and pupils - ran across the road and went down Hob Lane to crouch beneath the trees until it was safe to return.

The Home Guard performed beneath the authority of Major W. Wilson and mainly consisted of local farmers and presumably employees of the Wilsons. They were trained to throw hand grenades over hay stacks. The hand grenades were made by the battalion workers and some were quite hard and substantial but the result was the same – if you were hit you were dead and this guaranteed an early visit to one of the local public houses.

I was told that the Peacock at Owler Bar was a favourite training spot because some of the 'soldiers' had to be stationed on Totley Moss. On one occasion the man who was on guard on Totley Moss was missing and it took some time before he was found in the Peacock because he had run out of pipe tobacco and made it plain that his tobacco consumption was more important than any action from Deutschland.

When a Wellington bomber crashed on Big Moor with the reservoir full of frozen water, my informant told me that he was ordered to use his greatcoat to protect one of the crew who was injured. The plane was a write off and the following day a trailer called a 'Queen Mary' arrived and drove over what it thought was a pasture field but was in fact the frozen water. The loaded trailer then returned and followed its original route. The Home Guard watched in horror but nothing happened. I was told that the greatcoat had to be laundered at a cost of 2/3d and the owner had to pay the fee. He was not pleased.



MARCH 2024 WEATHER

I am becoming reluctant to say, yet again, how wet each month has been. The last seven months have all been wetter than normal. I recorded 105.1mm (just over 4 inches) during March and this is more than 50% higher than normal. Indeed, the last 12 months have been 50% wetter than normal.

I am writing this report on the 7th April and the footpaths around Holmesfield are still extremely muddy and the field at East Hollow, across the road from the Rutland Arms, is flooded yet again.

The month of March was half a degree warmer than normal and the warmest day was on the 17th when the temperature reached 14.9°C. The minimum temperature was -0.7°C on the 3rd. We had 15% less sunshine than normal.

I remarked in my report on February's weather that snow was forecast for nine days after my time of writing on 12th March. As it turned out that forecast was wrong and no snow appeared on 21st March. The Met. Office boasts that its forecasts have become more accurate as their computer models have become increasingly sophisticated. The main claim made is that their forecasts for four days ahead are now as accurate as they used to be for the following day. What about a forecast for nine days hence? I have sympathy with the Met. Office as it is very difficult to assess the accuracy of a forecast. They actually use a method called ensembles to estimate a forecast's accuracy. For example, if they make a forecast for four days hence they will run their supercomputer several times with small differences in the current conditions that are entered into it. If all the answers are similar then they are reasonably confident that the forecast will be correct. However, if the ensemble of answers are very different then the forecast is likely to be wrong. NOAA (National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration), who make the weather predictions in the USA suggest that a seven-day forecast can accurately predict the weather about 80 percent of the time and a five-day forecast can predict the weather accurately for approximately 90 percent of the time. However, a 10-day-or longerforecast is only right about half the time. These are average figures for accuracy throughout the year and in the USA of course.

Unfortunately, forecasts are less accurate at times when the weather is unsettled which is often the case in the UK. My conclusion is that it was not surprising that the forecast made on the 12th March for snow on the 21st March was no better than could have been made by guesswork. That said, the weather did become much colder on the 23rd and 24th of March and there was snow over parts of Scotland and the Pennines. So the Met. Office were not completely wrong.






