

DRONFIELD POLICE SAFER NEIGHBOURHOOD TEAM

May crime figures:

Public Order: 1, Total: 1 (-2 on April).

Last month we took part in a national initiative: *Operation Sceptre*. This saw us complete knife sweeps in our local parks, visit schools to educate young people about the dangers of knife crime, and we held knife amnesty opportunities in communal areas. One amnesty in particular saw us collect 56 knives! If you ever have any old and unwanted knives that you



need to dispose of safely, please bring them to us so we can ensure they don't fall into the wrong hands.

Regarding youth anti-social behaviour, as the weather improves more people are wanting to get out and about. This is good but we would like to urge parents and carers to have a chat with their young people about appropriate behaviour and what behaviour is acceptable out in public spaces.

We will, as always, be continuing our targeted patrols for anti-social behaviour and any behaviour deemed to be "anti-social" will be dealt with appropriately by the Dronfield Safer Neighbourhood Team. It's important for parents and carers to also be aware of where their young people are heading, who they are associating with, and what activities they are engaging in.



AVOID ONLINE MARKETPLACE SCAMS

Fraudulent buyers are leaving Derbyshire Facebook sellers out of pocket – here's how you can keep safe if you're having a clear out.

The reports we've received involve the buyer turning up to collect with a fake proof of payment, such as a screenshot of a bank transfer or payment receipt. This screenshot is then used to convince the sellers to hand over the goods.

However, when the seller checks their bank account, they never received the money and they're left out of pocket.

Our Sock it to the Scammers video highlights how to protect against this type of scam. Including to always verify that you've received payment through a trusted means such as your online banking app or a trusted payment provider.

Tammy Barnes, Derbyshire Constabulary's Fraud Protect Officer, said: "Most sellers feel inclined to trust a buyer who comes to their house or public place to pick up and pay for items, it has a personal touch. Sellers whether online or in person may be conned by a buyer who claims to have transferred the money but it must be experiencing a delay.

"Unfortunately if you allow a buyer to leave before payment has been received, you may never see the item or the scammer who stole it again.

"Our advice is 'Stop. Think fraud.' Don't be rushed into any decisions and make sure the balance has appeared in your bank account or account with the selling site before sending your items."

Our #SockItToTheScammers campaign launched earlier this year, with other videos focussing on issues such as romance fraud and fake police phone calls. The campaign has resulted in members of the public remembering the **Stop. Think. Tell**. advice and stopping the scam in its tracks.


Recent cases in Derbyshire have shown just how much of an impact a marketplace scam can have, with sellers losing out on thousands of pounds by handing over items such as technology, jewellery and vehicles without receiving payment.

In Derbyshire, phones and laptops are the most common items that scammers will take without payment.

In the example of online marketplace fraud, whilst the scam might seem simple, it can often be effective by the scammer being insistent in messages and creating a false sense of urgency.

Tammy continued: "Always use your own trusted links, never follow a weblink supplied by the buyer. If someone is being intimidating, please contact us for further assistance."

"If the sale doesn't feel right, or you have concerns, always think of Claude and 'Stop. Think fraud'."

UNDERSTANDING ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR (ASB)

We hear the term ASB often, but do you know what is classed as anti-social behaviour? Often reports may not be necessary or they're reported to the wrong agency. Find out the correct reporting method and how we can support you on Derbyshire's ASB Hub: www.saferderbyshire.gov.uk/asbhub



Understanding anti-social behaviour (ASB)

We hear the term used often, but do you know what classes as anti-social behaviour? The law defines anti-social behaviour as behaviour that 'causes, or is likely to cause, harassment, alarm or distress to any person'.

What anti-social behaviour is:

Anti-social behaviour covers many types of behaviour, such as:

- Noise nuisance
- · Criminal damage, vandalism, graffiti
- · Intimidation, threats, harassment
- · Litter, dog fouling, fly tipping
- Deliberate fire setting
- Nuisance vehicles
- . Drunken and rowdy behaviour in a public place or drug misuse
- · Hate behaviour, targetting people because of their perceived differences.

What we take into consideration: How often the behaviour is happening, how serious it is and how it affects the people living in the community.

What anti-social behaviour is not:

A lot of reports to us are not necessarily acts of ASB, such as:

- · The sound of children playing or a baby crying
- Everyday living noises, such as toilet flushing, closing doors, vacuuming
- · Minor personal disputes and differences
- Young people gathering socially, unless they are being intimidating
 Someone being parked outside of your home, where there are no
- Someone being parked outside or your nome, where there are no lawful restrictions in place
- DIY and car repairs unless they are taking place at unsocial hours
- Civil disputes between neighbours (e.g. shared driveways)
- · Religious or cultural practice.

MAY 2024 WEATHER

Well, my summary of the weather for the last month is yet again WET, WET! I recorded 77mm of rainfall during May. This is now the ninth month in succession where the rainfall has been more than normal. We had 16 days where I recorded some rain and indeed on the 22nd May the rain fell for 20 of the 24 hours and well over an inch of rain accumulated.

I remember as a boy, wondering how much water there was in a large cloud and how long could the rain continue before the cloud was empty. Well a small cloud might contain about 500 tons of water and a large thunder cloud can contain up to a million tons. You can understand why some nervous people don't feel safe when standing underneath a large cloud! Fortunately, clouds don't actually burst and it seems that a single cloud can only produce heavy rain for about 20 minutes before the water contained is exhausted. Often of course, clouds move past us and are replaced by more clouds so the rain can continue for a long time.

Another thing that puzzled me about clouds when I was a young boy was why clouds float above us and do not fall down as they contain water that is heavy? Well the answer to that question is that water vapour is less dense than air so that a cloud will float above the air. If you watch the steam cloud from a boiling kettle it rises because it weighs considerably less than the air.

How clouds form depends upon many things such as the wind, heating of the ground and the presence of mountains and this means that the study of clouds is difficult and indeed not fully understood.

Another memorable aspect of the weather this May is that it was unusually warm. The Met. Office said that it was the warmest May in their records. I recorded an average temperature of 12.7°C for May and this is my second warmest May in the last twenty years. May 2018 was slightly warmer at 13.1°C. I must say that May this year did not feel warm. The highest temperature I recorded was 23.6°C on 12th May and the lowest 6.9°C on 8th May. I think that the reason why we did not feel warm is because there was not much sunshine and there were many days when the wind was cold, coming from the north-east. We don't like cold draughts or winds.
