



SCAM CAR PARK OR CODES

Derbyshire County Council parking officers are warning you not to be fooled by scam QR codes on parking machines.

Fake QR codes used by scammers have been spotted on pay and display machines in Derbyshire prompting a warning to motorists not to fall for the fake payment method.



A driver in Chesterfield reported being stung by scammers after his bank warned him the payment he'd made using a QR code stuck onto a pay and display machine was suspicious.

An immediate investigation discovered several pay and display machines in Chesterfield had a roque QR code sticker on them which have now been removed.

The county council does not use QR codes for payments for on-street parking so if there are QR codes on the machines, they're not legitimate.

DARKER NIGHTS HAVE SEEN AN INCREASE IN ATTACKS ON FARMS AND RURAL PROPERTIES

The darker nights have seen an increase in attacks on farms and rural properties. We are working hard to identify and pursue those responsible but we are asking that farmers and rural communities are vigilant and take all reasonable measures to protect their property.

- Look for existing weaknesses Before you put any security measures in place, you'll need to analyse your existing set-up. It may be you are already as secure as you can be in certain areas but there may also be glaring gaps that need to be filled. The only way to find out is to check thoroughly and think like a criminal. If possible, keep vehicles/ machinery out of sight in a lockable building or garage and always remove machinery from fields, especially near roads when it is not in use.
- Consider your land and buildings from the perspective of a potential thief. What weaknesses can you spot? If you were trying to break in, what route would you choose? If you were planning to leave with bulky equipment how would you do it? This will allow you to address the most urgent problems first.
- Install security measures Technology can offer a real advantage in deterring criminals. This includes alarms, security systems and motion activated lights. Put alarms on doors to buildings and point CCTV cameras at the most vulnerable spots on your farm.
- Visible deterrents will also help. Many criminals on farms are chancers or simply not
 that good at their chosen profession. Any form of obvious security could make them
 think twice and choose somewhere else to carry out their illegal activities. A loud alarm
 could well encourage them to flee empty handed. Visible security may also discourage
 the more innocent from straying on your land and scaring your animals.
- Check and double check locks on windows and doors. There are good locks and there are locks that anyone with a little knowledge can open quite easily. Check that your padlocks are strong consider covers to them to stop them being cut through. Don't forget the hinges of the doors, as these can be real weak points. This is not an area where cost savings reap long term benefits. Try and get the best equipment you can as your locks can make a real difference between a safe and unsecured farm. And don't forget to store keys in places that aren't obvious as well.
- Check the perimeter Security starts as soon as your land begins. Bolstering your perimeter security could include additional fencing, ditches to prevent unauthorised vehicles accessing your land and thick prickly hedges. Make sure existing infrastructure is in good working order. Don't offer any obvious open doorways to your property.
- Consider branding and serial numbers Take the protection of your equipment and vehicles seriously. You can brand your equipment with unique serial numbers such as etching into a window or the bodywork. Take photos as well. If your equipment is stolen, this will help with the recovery. Consider everything of value. For example, GPS kit theft has been a problem in recent years.

• Finally, always report suspicious visitors or behaviour on, at, or around your property to the police at the earliest opportunity.

HOME SECURITY OVER THE WINTER MONTHS

As the darker autumn nights approach, we would like to remind residents to think about home security during the late afternoon and evenings.

By taking some simple steps you can reduce the chance of your home being a potential target to criminals, so we urge residents to keep windows and doors locked and secure at all times, whether they are in or out of the home.

Other advice and tips include:

- Make use of good outdoor security lighting to put off a burglar.
- Make your home look occupied when you are out- avoid leaving curtains closed during the day and use automatic timer switches to turn lights on when it gets dark.
- Consider fitting a burglar alarm make sure it is installed properly by a reputable firm and is working. Also remember to set it before you leave home.
- A thorny hedge along the boundary of your property may put thieves off, as may a gravel path, as it's noisy to walk on.
- Always close any gates and secure them with a lock.
- Trim back any hedges or plants that a burglar could hide behind.

We also encourage people to be a good neighbour and to contact the police if you see anyone acting suspiciously in your area. Call 101 for a non-emergency, and 999 in an emergency situation.



SEPTEMBER - OCTOBER WEATHER 2024

I remarked last month that all the months this year-except for June and August - had been wetter than normal. Well, September has continued the deluge with almost eight inches of rain - almost three times the normal rainfall for September. Actually almost half of this rain fell on just one day – 30th September. That was not quite the wettest day that I have ever recorded but it was certainly sufficient to fill up what we refer to as Holmesfield Pond, the field at East Hollow just beyond The Rutland.

As I write these notes in the middle of October the wet weather has continued with two very wet days on 8th and 9th October. Much of the UK has had a lot of rainfall over the last few weeks. Holmesfield escaped much of the heavy rainfall during the first half of September, but we caught up with the rest of the country towards the end of the month. In addition to being very wet, September was also rather cold, with a mean temperature of 11.9°C, which is about one and a half degrees below normal.

The three inches of rainfall that fell on 30th September seemed to be a lot but Hurricane Milton that swept across Florida on 9th October dropped eighteen inches of rain on some parts.

Around midnight in Holmesfield on 8th October we had a very heavy shower when the rain fell at a rate of four inches an hour. Fortunately, that continued for only about 10 minutes, whereas in Florida it must have continued for several hours.

I quite like the sound of rain and indeed you can buy sound tracks of rainfall which are claimed to help relaxation and offer stress relief. I guess that this only applies if the rainfall is not sufficient to threaten your house, or even your life.

There are many poems written about rainfall. Henry Wadsworth Longfellow wrote;

Be still, sad heart! and cease repining; Behind the clouds is the sun still shining; Thy fate is the common fate of all, Into each life some rain must fall, Some days must be dark and dreary.




